Please be aware that there is monitoring software installed on all of the laptops and the school receives reports of which websites have been accessed plus any inappropriate search terms.

Free Mobile data

If you are accessing the internet via your mobile phone, then you may be eligible for free additional data to support your child's home learning. A number of the network providers have signed up to this initiative. If you would like to take advantage of this offer, then please send an email with your name, mobile number and network provider to Mrs Thoburn marked for my attention. School can then apply for this on your behalf.
