Drawing Dogs at Queen's Hall

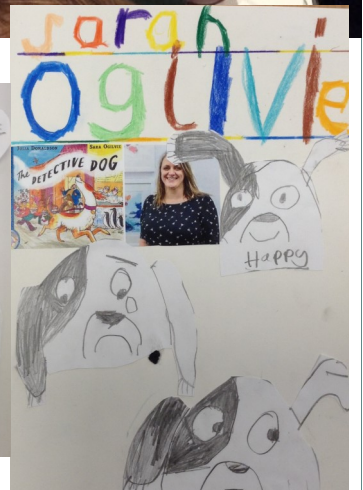
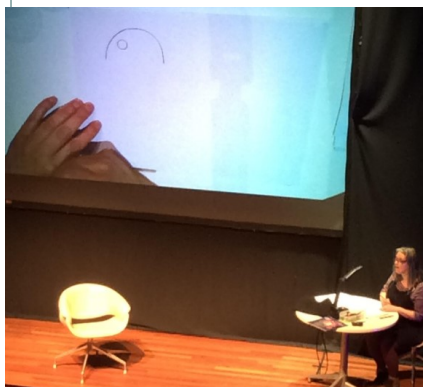
