There will be an additional Animation club on July 16th.

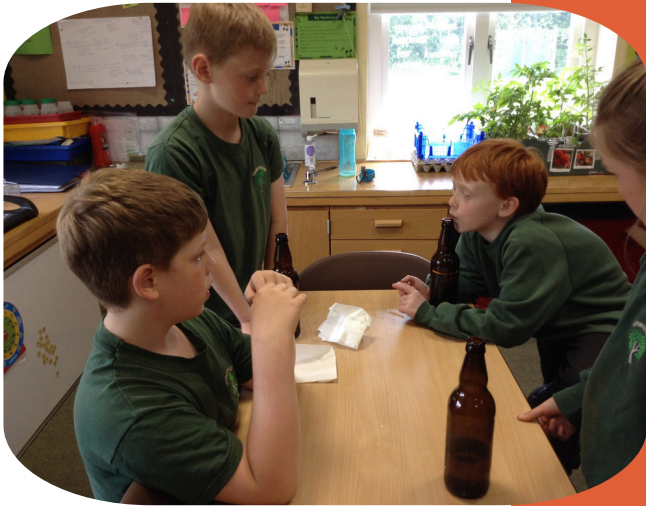
Class 1

Mrs Ewen writes: In class 1 the children learn in lots of different ways. This could be completing directed tasks with an adult or exploring the provision with friends or on their own. We love seeing children engage in activities together, developing their communication and social skills, and applying what they have learnt! Earlier this year we learnt about different habitats around the world. It filled me with joy the other day to see the children create an underwater habitat using the resources in class, researching in books and working together to ensure the animals had what they needed to survive. Great work Class 1!



Class 2

Mrs Johnston writes; It's been a noisy classroom recently! We have been learning about sound in Science. Now we know all about the anatomy of the ear and how we hear. We took our learning further by experimenting with pitch – we used bottles with differing amounts of water and blew across the top of them to produce sound then positioned ourselves in order of lowest to highest pitch. In Geography, we have been learning about where our food comes from and how it is sourced. We now know that producers get better deals when they work with organisations such as Fairtrade, but also recognise that not everyone can afford to make that choice.
