Class 1 have really been getting to grips with our understanding of shapes. We can identify and name shapes and are growing more confident when using the vocabulary sides, edges, faces and vertices. The children are enjoying our class text, Toys in Space and they have been producing some fantastic writing from it, including party invitations, space logs and diaries. In our science lessons the children are confidently naming different materials and understand what a material is. We are exploring the properties of materials, how we describe them, to help us understand why they are used for certain objects. This knowledge is also being used in our history lessons, as we look at and describe toys from different ages. understanding of how things change over time.
