Back to school!

We have had a lovely first two weeks back in school. Class 1 have been looking at traditional tales and have started a research project on farm animals. They have also used the computers to have a go at drawing some aboriginal style art. Our new Reception children have settled well and have been exploring their new classroom.



Class 2 have started their new topics; Rocks and the Stone Age. We have sorted rocks from hard to soft (testing them by scraping) and also investigated which rocks are permeable and which are impermeable. We discovered sedimentary rocks are soft and permeable! We also had a mock "archeological dig" in the classroom. We found arrow and axe heads as well as other artefacts and have tried our hand at cave painting. In Forest school we are creating dens and are going to plan and build a stone age shelter!
