We have had a busy half term in class 1. There has been some fantastic magic spells written in English, using expanded noun phrases, prepositions and powerful verbs! The



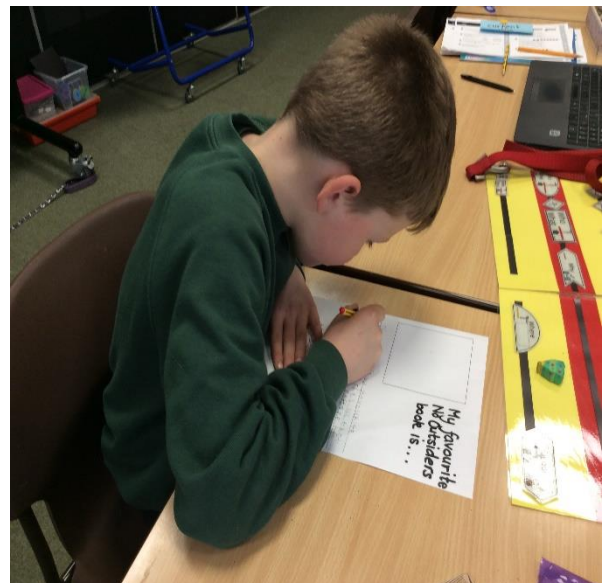
Year 2s have been exploring fractions and the Year 1s are getting to grips with counting in groups of 2s, 10s and 5s – keep practising!
