

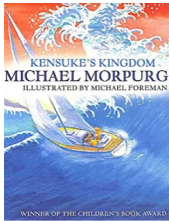

Autumn Term 1 (Cycle 2)- 2024

English

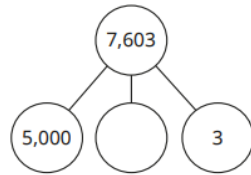
We will be basing our writing and reading comprehension work on the text 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo. We will explore how a text can raise issues and how the author can use 'flashbacks' to help us understand a character or situation.

We will write letters in character, create Haikus and write events from a different character's viewpoint.



Maths - Place Value

In Maths, we will be exploring place value - understanding how to represent, order, compare and partition numbers. We will use number lines and then move on to rounding numbers. We will complete the unit by learning the values of Roman Numerals.



Science - What's in the ground?

We will group rocks on the basis of appearance and simple physical properties. We will describe how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock. We will learn that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.



Music

Northumberland Music Partnership will be beginning instrument tuition. This will be a choice of saxophone, clarinet or flute.



PSHE - Can I build relationships with other people?

We will think about our different relationships with others and what can affect these. We will learn about effective communication and about how our manners change in different situations.



Geography - Who lives in Antarctica?

We will be learning about how latitude and longitude link to climate. We will also explore the physical and human features of polar regions with links to the explorer, Ernest Shackleton.



RE - What do Hindus believe God is like?

We will be learning the names of some Hindu deities and what they tell us about what Hindus believe God is like. We will be learning about how Hindus worship and what good and bad karma is.



Computing - What is audio editing?

We will look at devices capable of recording digital audio, including identifying the input device and output devices. We will discuss the ownership of digital audio and the copyright implications of duplicating the work of others.



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Art & DT - How can I use paint effectively?

We will be learning how to darken and lighten paint colours and use tints and shades to create 3D effects. We will use paint effects to plan and create a Still Life painting.



PE

In PE this term we will be learning skills for invasion games, football and tag rugby.



French – Where do I live?

We will be learning how to see where we live and also to describe the rooms we have in our houses.
